All new first year students are required to pay a non-refundable deposit of £200.00 upon acceptance to hold their place on the course; this deposit will be counted towards the first fees payment. For students who do not require a visa to enter the UK (that is, UK and European Union citizens), at least 50% of the course fees are payable on arrival at the college with the remainder due by 31 May the following year. The MTh in Old Testament and MTh in New Testament are ordinarily only available as full time courses.

Please note that for immigration purposes, all students who require a visa to enter the UK will be required to pay their course fees in full by 1 July before the course starts. The Graduate School will not be able to support any application for a student visa until all first year fees are paid. Please ask the Graduate School for guidance on this process.

All new first year students are required to pay a non-refundable deposit of £200.00 upon acceptance to hold their place on the course; this deposit will be counted towards the first fees payment. For UK or European Union students, at least 50% of the course fees are payable on arrival at the first class session with the remainder due by 31 May. Because of the delivery mode of this course, it is not available to students who would require a visa to study in the UK. This course is also not available for full-time study.

These fees do not include accommodation. Accommodation for full time doctoral students is as per the amount for full time MTh students. Likewise, part time DMin fees do not include accommodation for tutorial sessions.

Should you require an extension in order to complete your course a further fee of £650 will be payable for each year. You should not presume extensions will automatically be granted to you.
